## Marbled Paper

### Supplies:

- Shaving cream
- Shallow dish or plate
- Eye dropper
- Liquid watercolor
- Cardstock or white art paper
- A straw for swirling

### Instructions:

1. Add a layer of shaving cream into your dish
2. Using liquid watercolor, drip a few colors on top of the shaving cream
3. Use a straw to swirl the colors together
4. Gently press your paper into the colored shaving cream
5. Lift the paper up and scrape off the shaving cream to reveal your marbled paper!
6. Set aside to dry

## Learn How to Save, Spend, and Donate with Jars!

How can jars help you understand the basics of money management? Start with three clear jars labeled save, spend, and donate.

**Save:** Your save jar is to hold money that you're saving for something specific. Maybe you're interested in getting a new scooter or electronic game. Write the item and amount you'll need to purchase it on the front of your jar so you're reminded of your saving goal. Add this money to your FAT CAT account as soon as you can and watch it grow!

**Spend:** This jar is ideal for money that you may want to spend right away on smaller, less expensive items.

**Donate:** Giving to those in need is an important part of being involved in your local community. Use this jar to set aside money you can donate to a cause that's important to you. For example, if you love animals, with the help of your parents or guardians, you can find a local animal shelter or organization to assist.

Each time you earn an allowance or receive money for chores, gifts, etc., divide it up among your jars. In no time you'll start seeing the progress you've made!
