North Carolina State Quarter

The U.S. Mint, which creates and distributes coins and medals, produced special quarters for all 50 states from 1999 to 2008. Each state quarter features the same design on the front, showing the familiar image of George Washington, but the back is unique for each state.

The North Carolina quarter features the "First Flight," which took place in 1903 by Orville and Wilbur Wright near Kitty Hawk, North Carolina. The brothers designed the first motorized flying machine and managed to fly approximately 120 feet, an impressive feat at the time!

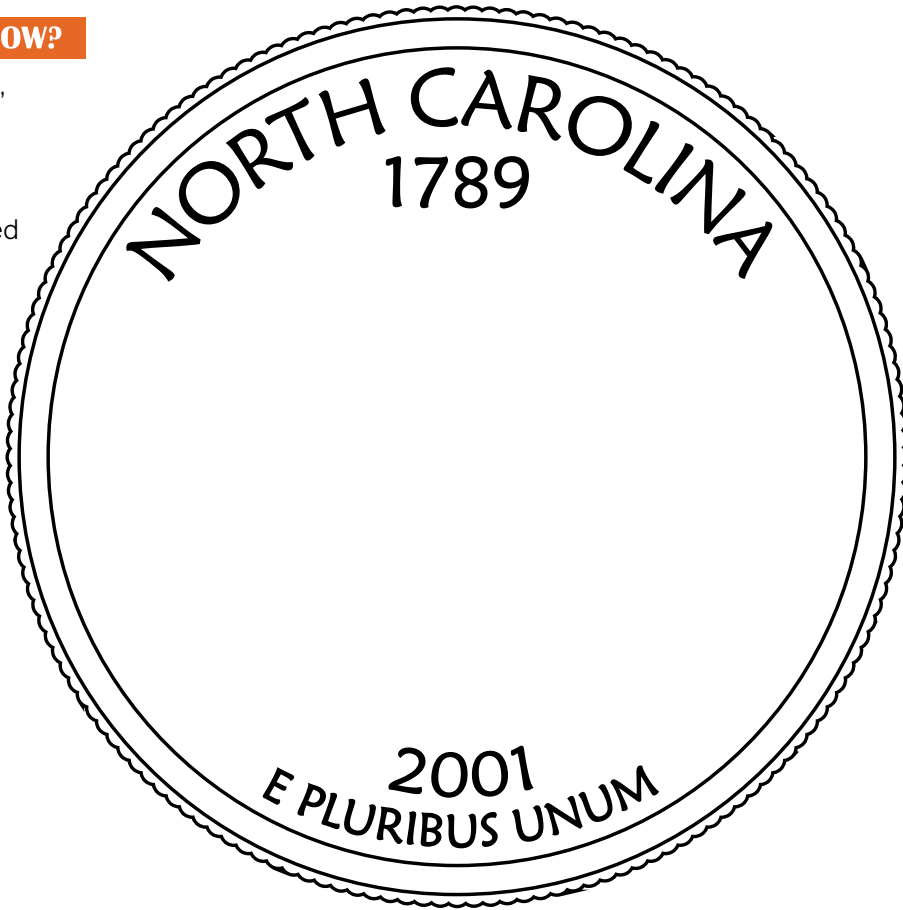
